## **Home school Agreement Parent Support policy**

### **Newsletters**

### **Parent's meetings**

- Key Stages meetings to outline curriculum plans for the year
- Parents Day to discuss progress and targets for the year and general feedback if required by the parent or teacher.
- Open day to discuss progress in meeting targets and general feedback to parents on progress.
- An opportunity to discuss the annual report and to answer any questions based on the report, if required by the parent/guardian.
- SEN review meetings with SENCo and class teacher to review and set Individual Education Plans.
- Other meetings will be arranged to deal with specific problems or activities. I.e. discipline, etc.

### **Complaints.**

The school has a complaint procedure in place to deal with any issues which parents may have.
